DIRECTOR'S NOTES

THIS PLAY WAS SUPPOSED TO BE A TEEN PRODUCTION OF (LUE, A PLAY BASED ON A MOVIE BASED ON THE FAMOUS BOARD GAME THAT MOST OF US HAVE PLAYED WITH FAMILY AND FRIENDS: WHO KILLED MR. BODDY? AND WHERE? AND WITH WHAT WEAPON? BUT ONE WEEK BEFORE AUDITIONS, OUR RIGHTS TO PERFORM (LUE WERE CANCELLED AND CTC WAS LEFT WITH A BIG HOLE IN THE SCHEDULE. WHAT TO DO?

I MET WITH A HALF DOZEN OF THE THE "KIDS" WHO WERE PLANNING TO AUDITION FOR CLUE. THEY SUGGESTED THAT WE DO PUFFS. "WHAT??!!." I SAID.

AFTER AUDITIONS, WE WERE THREE WEEKS BEHIND. NO SCRIPTS, NO PROPS OR COSTUMES, NO SET DESIGN AND ONLY EIGHT OF THE ELEVEN ACTORS WE NEEDED. WE MADE CALLS. THREE MORE ACTORS SHOWED UP. STILL NO SCRIPTS. PROPS, COSTUMES OR SET. BUT I HAD A CAST – A WONDERFUL CAST. THE OTHER THING I HAD WAS A PHENOMENAL ASSISTANT DIRECTOR. I HAD ACTED WITH CHRIS ROMERO IN PARADE. CHRIS HAD RECENTLY "GRADUATED" FROM THE CTC TEEN PROGRAM WHEN HE TURNED TWENTY, HAD AGREED TO WORK WITH ME ON CLUE, AND HAD BEEN PART OF THE PUFFS DISCUSSION FROM THE BEGINNING. WITHOUT HIM, WE WOULDN'T BE HERE. THANKS. (HRIS.

SO HERE WE ARE. A SET CANNIBALIZED FROM THE LAST PLAY, AND COSTUMES AND PROPS DONATED BY CAST MEMBERS AND THEIR FAMILIES.

THIS HAS BEEN A GREAT EXPERIENCE FOR ME. SHARING THIS ADVENTURE WITH SUCH A TALENTED YOUNG ENSEMBLE AND ONE OVER-THE-HILL ASSISTANT DIRECTOR. NOT TO MENTION OUR WONDERFUL ONE-PERSON TECH CREW AND ONE-PERSON STAGE CREW.

ENJOY THEIR YOUTH, ENERGY AND TALENT. WHEN WE CLOSE I'M GOING HOME TO TAKE A LONG NAP.


